

Information on the Duna Medical Center's epidemiological rules applicable from 8 March 2022

Registration

Outpatient and inpatient treatment at the institute is available by prior reservation.

Hand disinfection

The use of alcohol-based hand sanitiser is mandatory upon arrival.

Wearing a mask

The use of a textile mask or a surgical mask covering the nose and mouth is compulsory during the stay in the institution.

COVID pre-screening

Patients with respiratory disease or other symptoms of COVID-19 may be admitted to the clinic if they have previously undergone a negative antigen screening test at the clinic. The cost of the rapid antigen test is HUF 3,630 and is to be paid by the patient. If the patient has a positive PCR test result within 7 days, our institution will not provide care.

Rules for surgery

For patients coming for surgery a negative result of a rapid antigen test on the day of the procedure are required to be eligible for care.

Visit to the inpatient ward

Each patient may be admitted to the in-patient ward of the hospital for a maximum of 2 visitors per day for 30-30 minutes, or for a maximum of 60 minutes if 1 visitor is admitted.

Accompanying person staying with an inpatient

An accompanying person staying with the patient throughout the entire stay for minor, disabled or other reasonable reasons shall be admitted to the in-patient ward only if he/she has a negative result of the rapid antigen test on arrival.

Testing before delivery

In the case of spontaneous labour, induction of labour or for patients arriving for a programmed caesarean section a rapid antigen test is required on arrival. In the case of a positive result of either test, the woman giving birth will be treated at the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology of Semmelweis University, which is designated for COVID care.

Rules for obstetric visitors and accompanying persons

A maximum of 2 visitors per day for 30 to 30 minutes, or 60 minutes if 1 visitor is present, is allowed to visit mothers in the maternity centre. An attendant who arrives for delivery and stays in the maternity centre and a visitor may only enter the maternity centre only after a negative result of a rapid antigen test carried out on arrival at the facility at the visitor's expense.
